In continuation to this Council's earlier conditional approval letter of even number dated 23.5.96, I am directed to state that on consideration of the observations made by the Expert Committee (Date : 31.8.96) and the recommendations made by the Southern Regional Committee, (27.9.96), the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), accords its permission to State Govt. of Tamil Nadu for admissions to MARUTHI POLYTECHNIC MANIVIZHUNTHAN (SOUTH) ATTUR TALUK - PIN - 636 121 SALEM DIST. to conduct following Diploma course(s) in ENGINEERING & TECHNOLOGY with an annual intake mentioned against each for the session 1996-97 provided the last date of admissions is not over. If the last date is over, then this approval may be treated for 1997-98.

This approval has been accorded subject to fulfillment of specific and general conditions as listed in Annexure I & II respectively. All other conditions as mentioned in Council's earlier letter of even number dated 23.5.96 remains unchanged and should be fully complied with by the institution. You are requested kindly to take further action.

The admission will be made in accordance with Regulations notified by the AICTE vide GSR 476(E) dated 20.05.1994 based on the hon'ble Supreme Court Judgement dated 04.02.1993 with regard to WP(C) No. 607 of 1992 in the case of Unni Krishanan JP and other etc. V/s. State Government of Andhra Pradesh and others etc. and later judgements. No Management/Institute/Trust or Society shall announce admissions directly under any circumstances. Any action contrary to this provision taken by the institute will make it liable to be derecognised.

Further in the event of infringement/contravention or non-compliance of the conditions prescribed by the AICTE by December 1996. The Council shall take further action to withdraw approval to these cases for admission during 1997-98 and the liability arising out of such withdrawal of approval will be solely that of Management/Trust/Society and/or Institutions.

You are requested to kindly monitor the progress made by these institutions for fulfillment of conditions laid down in this approval and keep the Southern Regional Committee and AICTE informed.

ANNEXURE II

No. F. 30-52-146(E) IET/9

### General Conditions

1. No new course(s) shall be started or an ongoing course(s) shall be discontinued without the prior approval of the AICTE.
2. The intake capacity in any of the approved course(s) shall not be increased or varied without the prior approval of the AICTE.
3. Adequate funds shall be available with the Institution to meet the financial obligations of recurring and non-recurring nature as prescribed by the AICTE, from time to time.
4. All infrastructural, instructional and other facilities shall be provided as per the AICTE norms prescribed from time to time.
5. Teaching and other staff shall be selected according to the procedure, qualifications, experience and pay scales as prescribed by AICTE from time to time, and that they shall be paid full salaries and allowances regularly and in time.
6. The tuition and other fees shall be charged as prescribed by the State Government within the overall criteria/limits as may be laid down by the AICTE from time to time.
7. Admissions shall be made according to the regulations and directions of the AICTE for such admissions in the respective technical institution or university.
8. The State Government policies for admissions of SC/ST, other weaker sections of Society etc., shall be followed by the Institution.
9. Institution by virtue of the approval by AICTE shall not automatically become eligible to receive financial grants or assistance from the Central or State Governments.
10. Institution shall maintain records and books of accounts as prescribed by the Competent Authority.
11. The Accounts of the Institution shall be audited by Chartered Accountant or any agency authorised by the Competent Authority and shall be open for inspection by the AICTE or any body authorised by it.
12. The Institution shall be subject to a Special Audit and inspection as prescribed by the AICTE.
13. Institution shall furnish requisite returns as prescribed by Competent Authority/AICTE for ensuring maintenance of standards.
14. The Institution may be visited by an officer or a Committee of the AICTE or of its Regional Office from time to time to review the progress made by the Institution in fulfilling the conditions as laid down by the AICTE.

### Additional Conditions for Pvt. and Grant-in-Aid technical institutions :

15. The Governing Body of the institution shall be constituted, and its Chairman shall be appointed as per the guidelines of AICTE.
16. The institution shall not charge any Capitation Fee or donation for admission or other higher charges from the students/guardians of the students in any form.
17. The Institution shall constitute a Planning and Monitoring Board (PMB) for the continuous monitoring of implementation of norms and standards of the AICTE. There shall be an evaluation of the Institution in a plan period by the AICTE.
18. The institution should create an Endowment fund jointly in the name of the institution and the concerned State Authority to the tune of 30% of the projected peak annual recurring expenditure or as prescribed by the State Govt./UT or Rs. 10 lakhs, whichever is more.

Specific Conditions :

1. AC sheet roofing, plastering, flooring, fixing of window frames and doors, entrance doors, electrical fittings and electrical connections etc. should be completed.
2. The labs. should be fully established alongwith roofing, water, light, electricity, gas connection etc.
3. Carpentry, smithy, fitting and sheet metal workshop alongwith work tables and tools should be completed.
4. Library facilities for the first year classes alongwith necessary furniture, books, journals etc. including reading room as per AICTE norms should be created.
5. This approval for establishment of institution for the year 1996-97 is subject to fulfilling of the deficiencies before June 30, 1996 or prior admissions whichever is earlier.
6. Other infrastructural facilities should be created prior admissions.
7. The adequate finances should be provided for meeting recurring and non recurring expenses of the proposed institution.
8. One Principal, HODs and teaching & non teaching staff should be appointed and gradually brought at par with the AICTE norms.
9. AICTE scales of pay alongwith applicable allowances should be granted to the teaching and non teaching faculty.
10. The institution should create an endowment fund jointly in the name of the institution and the concerned State authority to the tune of 30% of the projected peak annual recurring expenditure or as prescribed by State Govt./ Union Territory or Rs. 10 lakhs whichever is more.
11. The institute should use the proposed area exclusively for the college.
12. The construction work of building at permanent site should be completed with 6 to 8 months..
13. Infrastructural and other facilities in terms of faculty, laboratories, workshops, library etc. for the first year and subsequent years of classes should be established in the new campus well in advance before the actual commencement of that year
